
Photography Alphabet Challenge....

The task, like these examples, is to create an alphabet out of photographs that can be read as letters.

Once you have taken the photographs arrange them to fit in a rectangle like this one...possibly in a word document or similar.



It is important to get a variety of images and colour where you are seeing the letters in the world around you. Not just to seek out a sign or a block of text and photograph all the letters in it. A good example is this Z in the door.

Simple roadsigns like a P for parking would be good or the H symbol on a fire-hydrant, but the best/ cleverest are often the ones that have a less obvious and unexpected twist, like the M in the windows below, which we see, partly as the preceding L and following N gives the viewer a clue.

This is a task about observation skills and looking closely at the world around you. The letters are all there waiting to be photographed....you just have to notice them.
