It was the first vote held since 2022, the two year approach providing Members of Youth Parliament with sufficient time to campaign on their chosen priority issue. ## YOUTH POPULATION CHANGES

The UK Youth Parliament uses population figures from the Office for National Statistics's Population Estimates. Outside of the Census, which is collected every 10 years, this gives the best available picture of the population. Using figures from the Office of National Statistics ensures a single and consistent approach across the whole of the UK; though UKYP recognises that these figures can differ from those collected locally.

Make Your Mark uses broad voting themes to allow newly elected Members of Youth Parliament to conduct localised research, better understanding how an issue impacts upon the communities and people they stand to represent. This approach enables young people to have real ownership on the issues they choose to tackle.

The Centre for Youth Impact has supported the delivery of Make Your Mark 2024.
